

Spring Recital FAQ

When is the WSD Spring Recital?

WSD Recital Weekend is June 19-21. There are four performances:

Friday, June 19th – 6:00pm

Saturday, June 20th – 1:00pm

Saturday, June 20th – 6:00pm

Sunday, June 21st – 3:00pm

Creative Movement, Pre-Ballet/Tap and Level I students will only participate in one performance. All other dancers will participate in two performances. A full performance schedule will be published on our website and posted at the studio.

Are performances mandatory?

No. All WSD students from Creative Movement to Upper Levels are eligible to participate in the Spring Recital, but recital is just a small part of dance education.

Before committing to this year's performances, please make sure that rehearsals and performances will fit with your family's calendar.

Dancers must be present at all rehearsals and assigned performances without exception. If you are **NOT** taking part in this year's performance, please inform the studio by March 1st.

What is the commitment for performers and their families?

We do have high expectations of those who chose to perform. It's important to understand the commitment of performance ahead of time.

- To participate in the performance, dancers must order a costume which range from \$55.00 - \$75.00 for each class. Additional costs include tickets for family and friends, and optional expenses such as photography or the purchase of a DVD of the performance.
- Regular class attendance is imperative to ensure that students are well prepared. Dancers attending less than 80% of their Semester II classes may be asked to withdraw from the performance.
- All participating students must attend their assigned Dress Rehearsal and all of their assigned Performances.
- Participating students stay backstage during their assigned performance.

When are costumes ordered?

Costume orders for all participating students will be placed on March 1st. To order a costume:

- Visit the Parent Portal through our website
- Click on “Register for Classes” and then the “Recital Participation” tab
- Register for the “Recital Waiver” and all the class/es that you plan to perform with
- Check out to pay costume fees and register for the recital!

Costume availability is not guaranteed for families who pay after the costume fee due date, and late fees and additional shipping and handling may apply. There are no returns or refunds for costumes.

Are there additional rehearsals for performers?

Dress Rehearsals for the Spring Recital are scheduled for Wednesday, June 17th and Thursday, June 18th from 4:30pm – 6:00pm and 6:30 – 8:00pm. Rehearsal assignments can be found on the recital schedule.

What is ECA?

ECA is the Edmonds Center for the Arts in Edmonds, WA. Additional information about the theater can be found at www.edmondscenterforthearts.org

How much do tickets cost?

Each performance is divided into two Acts. This year, WSD audiences will have the option to purchase a ticket to the first Act of a given performance, the second Act of a given performance, or a combination ticket for two Acts of the same performance. Tickets for a single Act are **\$12.00** per person including transaction fees. A combination ticket for both of the same performance will be **\$18.00** per person including transaction fees.

All purchases must be made through the ECA box office. We do not sell tickets at the studio. WSD families are responsible for their own ticket purchases and WSD cannot guarantee availability for every performance. There will be no limits on ticket sales this year, so please plan ahead.

ECA does not allow for “babes in arms” so every person regardless of size must have a ticket of their own. Tickets are for **reserved seating**, and you will choose your seating configuration when you make your purchase from the ECA box office.

Performers do not need tickets – only audience members. Tickets will go on sale June 1st
