Spring Recital FAQ

When is the WSD Spring Recital?

WSD Recital Week is June 14-17, 2023, with dress rehearsal and performances at the Edmonds Center for the Arts in Edmonds, WA.

Creative Movement, Pre-Ballet/Tap, and Level I students will participate in one rehearsal and one performance.

All other dancers will participate in one rehearsal and two performances. A full performance schedule will be published on our website and posted at the studio. Please check the "**Recital Schedule**" to see when you class is scheduled to rehearse and perform.

Dress Rehearsals will be held during the evening of Wednesday, June 14th and Thursday, June 15th. The exact time of your dancer's rehearsal will be announced closer to Recital Week.

Performances are scheduled for: Friday, June 16th – 6:00pm Saturday, June 17th – 1:00pm Saturday, June 17th – 6:00pm

Are performances mandatory?

No. All WSD students from Creative Movement to Upper Levels are eligible to participate in the Spring Recital, but recital is just a small part of dance education and is not required.

Dancers must be present at all rehearsals and assigned performances without exception. Before committing to this year's performances, please make sure that rehearsals and performances will fit with your family's calendar. If you are **NOT** taking part in this year's performance, please inform the studio by February 15th.

How do I register my dancer for the Spring Recital?

Performance fees must be received by February 15th in order to participate in the Spring Recital. To register:

- Visit the Parent Portal through our website
- Click on "Register for Classes" and then the "Recital Participation" tab
- Register for the class/es that you plan to perform with
- Check out to pay performance fees and register for the recital
- Return a signed copy of the "2023 WSD Spring Recital Commitment Contract" to the front desk.

What is the commitment for performers and their families?

Dancers performing in the Spring Recital will be assessed a non-refundable performance fee, due by February 15th.

Regular class attendance is imperative to ensure that students are well prepared. Dancers attending less than 80% of their Semester II classes may be asked to withdraw from the performance.

All participating students must attend their assigned Dress Rehearsal and all of their assigned Performances.

Participating students stay backstage during their assigned performance.

How much do tickets cost?

Tickets are \$18.50. Performers do not need tickets – only audience members.

All purchases must be made through the ECA box office. We do not sell tickets at the studio. WSD families are responsible for their own ticket purchases and WSD cannot guarantee availability for every performance. There will be no limits on ticket sales this year, so please plan ahead.

ECA does not allow for "babes in arms" so every person regardless of size must have a ticket of their own. Tickets are for **reserved seating**, and you will choose your seating configuration when you make your purchase from the ECA box office.

Tickets will go on sale June 1st at 12:00pm.
